

War-Memorials of Japanese soldiers in CAPOOCAN

In Capooocan, there are some war-memorials in 3 places.

- ① Some war-memorial of Japanese 1st Infantry-Division at Break neck ridge in Brgy . Lemon(第一師団の慰霊碑など)
- ② A war-memorial of Japanese 1st Fire-Artillery-Regiment in Brgy. San Joaquin(鎮魂)
- ③ A war-memorial of Japanese Military-Engineer(工兵碑)



1. Some war-memorials of Japanese 1st Infantry-Division (Figure-A) /リモン峠頂上(ブレイクネックリッジ)にある第一師団の慰霊碑など



These war-memorials were built at the place called "Break Neck Ridge"; the top of northern Lemon pass.

If you want to go forward there from Tacloban, you will enter Brgy. Lemon after soon over top of the pass. And run about 200M from there, you will see stairway and a blue sign that shows Japanese war-memorials there on left side.


2. A war-memorial of Japanese 1st Fire-Artillery-Regiment(Figure-B) / 鎮魂(野砲兵第一連隊)



The war-memorial is located behind of San-Joaquin brgy hall ;pink building(at JAN2018)

A narrow graveled road reach to the war-memorial starts the place run 50M from the San-Joaquin brgy hall.

3. A war-memorial of Japanese Military-Engineer(Figure-C)/工兵碑



The war-memorial is also in Brgy. San-Joaquin but there is not any landmarks near there. So you should trust GPS on mapm
